Župna crkva Uznesenja Marijina ① Župna crkva Uznesenja Blažene Djevice Marije izrađena je u kasnorenesansnom stilu. U crkvi i oko nje pokapani su mrtvi, dok početkom 19. st. nije utemeljeno vangradsko groblje.

Crkvica Sv. Ivana ② U istočnom dijelu Sutivana, unutar temelja stare bazilike s trolisnim svetištem i predvorjem, danas se nalazi malena crkva Sv. Ivana Krstitelja s plemićkim grbom i natpisom na latinskom jeziku da je crkva podignuta 1655. god.

Crkva Sv. Roka ③ Crkva Sv. Roka, zaštitnika od kuge, sagrađena je 1623. Zvonik je sagrađen 1879., vidi se izdaleka i daje karakterističnu sliku Sutivanu. Oltar je izradio Pavao Bertapelle, 1787. U crkvi su drveni kip Sv. Roka i slike nepoznatog majstora: *Navještenje, Uskršnuće i Posljednja večera*.

Groblje i katakombe ⑤ Sutivansko je groblje smješteno na pošumljenom brežuljku zapadno od mjesta. Ljepota starog groblja je u njegovoj jednostavnosti. Grobovi su pokriveni kamenim pločama. Kroz kapelicu Bratovštine P.S. Sakramenta silazi se u katakombe, u kojima je 126 podzemnih grobova.

Sklop kuća Ilić ① Prvu utvrđenu palaču u Sutivanu podigao je Jakov Nadali – Božičević 1505. god. u renesansnom stilu. Nadalijev ili Natalijev, a kasnije Ilićev dvor ima prostrani park do danas sačuvan i obnovljen. Južni dio pretvoren je u javni park.



Kuća Marijanović ② Kuću Marijanović, kaštel u obliku kule, podigao je poljički doseljenik Janko Marijanović – Dražoević, poznat kao conte Janko, u 17. st. Jankov Dvor, vrlo slikovita nevelika zgrada, ima iskošen prizemni dio koji ostavlja dojam utvrde, s balkonom prema moru i sunčanim satom s južne strane.

Sklop kuća Definis ③ U kući Definis nalazila se bogata medicinska biblioteka iz 18. i ranog 19. st., kao i pet minijaturnih portreta članova obitelji Definis tršćanskog slikara, Vincenta Poireta (1813. – 1868.). Upravo se radi na rekonstrukciji čitavog sklopa zgrada.

Ljetnikovac Kavanjin ④ Splitski pjesnik Jerolim Kavanjin (1643. – 1714.) znatan dio života i književnog rada je proveo u Sutivanu. U luci je sagradio kuću Ilić ljetnikovac u baroknom stilu. Nad južnim dvorišnjim ulazom uklesao je natpis **OSTIVM NON HOSTIVM** – *Prijateljima vrata otvorena*. Na dvorištu pročelje zgrade postavljena je spomen ploča pjesniku sa stihovima iz njegove „velepiesni“.

Mlin (vjetrovica) ⑤ Kula nekadašnjeg mlina – vjetrenjače obitelji Ilić, iz početka 19. st., najbolje je sačuvan od 125 mlinova za žito na otoku Braču. Otkad je prestao mljeti žito više nema krila, ali djeluje slikovito na samoj morskoj obali, na istočnom dijelu mjesta.

Općinski dom ⑥ Među sutivanskim javnim građevinama ističe se Općinski dom iz 1898. god. Lijepa zgrada u povijesnom stilu od bijelog bračkog kamena.



Ascension of Mary Parish Church ① Ascension of Mary Parish Church was built in Late Renaissance style. The dead were buried inside and around the church until a cemetery was built outside town, at the beginning of the 19th century.

Church of St. John ② On the east side of Sutivan, inside the foundation of an old basilica with a three-leaf shrine and antechamber, lies little St. John the Baptist's church wearing a nobleman's crest inscribed with the year it was built, in 1655.

Church of St. Rocchus ③ Church of St. Rocchus (protector from plague) was built in 1623. The belfry was built in 1879, it is red, characteristic, and you can see it from afar. Pavao Bertapella made the altar in 1787. There is a wooden statue of St Roko in the church, and three paintings by an unknown artist: *Annunciation, Resurrection and Last Supper*.

Cemetery & Catacombs ⑤ Sutivan cemetery is on a forested hill west of the village. The beauty of the cemetery is in its simplicity. Most graves are covered by stone plates. There are catacombs with 126 graves underneath the chapel of the P.S. Sacrament Brotherhood. The catacombs are unique in Sutivan.

Ilić Complex ① The first mansion was built by Jakov Nadali – Božičević in 1505., in renaissance style. Nadalij's or Natalio's, and later Ilić court has a renovated and spacious park. The south part (of the park) was turned into a public park.

Marijanović house ② Marijanović house is a citadel built by immigrant Janko Marijanović – Dražoević, known as count Janko, in 17th century. Janko's Court is a picturesque building with a balcony facing the sea and sun dial on the south side.

Definis Complex ③ Definis house had a rich library with medieval books, from the 18th and early 19th century, and five miniature portraits of the Definis family by Trieste painter Vincent Poiret (1813 – 1868). The whole complex is currently being renovated.

Summer house Kavanjin ④ Split poet Jerolim Kavanjin (1643 – 1714) spent most of his creative life in Sutivan. He built a summer house in the port, in baroque style. He chiselled a message in stone above the south side of his yard: **OSTIVM NON HOSTIVM** – Friends are welcome. A memorial plaque was placed on the front side of the yard, with verses from his long poem.

Windmill ⑤ The Ilić family windmill from the 19th century is best preserved among 125 windmills. It has no wind turbines since it stopped grinding wheat, but it still looks beautiful towering above the sea.

Municipal building ⑥ Sutivan's Municipal building stands out among public buildings. It was built in 1898. A nice historical building made from white Brač stone.
